



CRIME SUMMARY REPORT

The Manchester Police Department handled 959 calls for service this month

07-01-08 1200 blk. of Pinyon
Stealing Over \$500

A resident reported items stolen from his vehicle overnight. The victim had left his vehicle unlocked and discovered \$450.00 cash and miscellaneous CDs stolen from the vehicle. The case is inactive at this time.

07-03-08 1100 blk. of Big Bend Crossing
Assault and Unlawful Use of a Weapon

Police were dispatched to the above location for a report of a domestic assault occurring in the driveway of a residence. The first officer arrived and the male suspect began to run away. The officer began a foot pursuit and continued even after being advised the male suspect had a gun. The officer saw the male reach for his rear waistband on his shorts, as he was running. The officer deployed a Taser X26 to temporarily incapacitate the suspect. A loaded .357 caliber revolver fell from the rear of the suspect's shorts, as he fell to the ground after being tased. The officer was able to draw her service weapon and retrieve the revolver from the suspect. The suspect was arrested and warrants have been issued against the suspect.

Assault

Police responded to a residence on Savoy for a report of an assault that occurred. The resident reported her live-in boyfriend had assaulted her earlier in the evening. The boyfriend then assaulted another male at the residence, because he believed the friend had told his girlfriend about another woman the suspect had been romantic with. The suspect was arrested for two counts of assault and was later released after posting bond for both assaults.

Stealing Over \$500

Police responded to Stonegate Apartments and were advised by a resident of items stolen from their vehicle. The resident's vehicle had a window broken out and cash, over 400 CDs and a Via Michelin GPS unit stolen. The case is still active and under investigation.

Property Damage

Police were dispatched to a local business in the above shopping center for a report of property damage. Unknown person(s) had spray painted several places on the rear of the business with graffiti. Police also located similar type graffiti on the median walls along Hwy. 141 and on an Ameren power pole. Further investigation by the detective bureau identified a suspect. The suspect has been arrested and warrant application is pending.

Police were dispatched to Waterford West Apartments for a report of a stealing from a vehicle. The resident reported his vehicle's window had been broken out and items stolen from the vehicle. An iPod and a Magellan GPS system were stolen from the vehicle. The case is inactive at this time.

Curfew and Possession of Marijuana

An officer on a foot patrol at Sue Fussner Field encountered five juveniles in the park. It was after midnight, which means the juveniles were in violation of curfew. The juveniles were arrested for curfew and two of the juveniles were also found to be in possession of marijuana. The juveniles were later released to their parents after processing. Leaving the Scene of an Accident

Police responded to Manchester Road for an auto accident. When officers arrived, they were informed that the driver of the vehicle causing the accident had left the scene. The officer was able to put together a photo lineup and the driver was positively identified. The driver has been located and this case is pending in the Manchester Municipal Court.

Burglary

Police were dispatched to a residence for a report of a burglary just discovered. The resident came home and found her dogs in the yard and the back door had been forced open. The master bedroom had been ransacked and the door and frame kicked in to gain entry to the residence had been damaged. Several neighbors reported seeing two white males in the area and hearing a loud bang. However, this information was not made available until after the crime had been discovered. The case is still active and under investigation.

Burglary

Police were dispatched to a residence for a report of a burglary. It was reported by one of the residents that his video camera, laptop computer and miscellaneous DVDs had been stolen in the burglary. The resident reported possibly leaving a rear sliding glass door unlocked when he left to spend the night at a relative's house. Another roommate reported hearing noises in the house during the night, but went back to sleep as he thought it was just his roommates walking in the house. The case is still active and under investigation.

Driving While Intoxicated

An officer on patrol observed a vehicle driving at a slow rate of speed on Manchester Road in the early morning hours. The officer then observed the vehicle swerve into the center turn lane and continue to drive in both lanes. The officer stopped the vehicle to investigate the erratic driving. The driver was found to be in possession of Heroin and was arrested for possession of heroin and drug paraphernalia. The driver was also charged with Driving While Under the Influence of Drugs. The case is pending lab analysis and warrant application to be made.

A resident reported a Garmin GPS unit stolen from his vehicle, while he had been away on vacation. The resident had left the vehicle in the driveway and he was unsure if he had secured his vehicle prior to leaving for vacation. The case is still active and under investigation.
