

# Manchester Arts Sculpture Exhibition 2016



**Manchester Arts and the city of Manchester** are seeking **public art sculptures** to exhibit for a 2 year period from October, 2016 to September, 2018. Original existing works from the artist in any media suitable for outdoors and family friendly will be considered, including sculpture, multimedia, and interactive. Up to two sculptures will be selected for this two year exhibition period.

**Entry Deadline is August 31, 2016**

**3 Entries per Artist Are Allowed, No Entry Fee Required**

**\$500 Honorarium** will be paid per sculpture to selected artists for the two year period.

Manchester Arts and selected judges will review applications after the deadline and notify the artist if accepted by **September 15, 2016**.

Installation is to occur in **October, 2016** at a mutually agreeable time, in a public place as selected by Manchester Arts and the city of Manchester within the city limits. See attached list of potential sites.

Artwork is to remain in place until **September, 2018**, at which time the artist is to remove it. Terms of a sale can be discussed during the time of exhibition, but the piece cannot be removed prior to September, 2018.

## 2016 Sculpture Exhibit Details

**Site:** All works are for outdoor placement and must be able to withstand exposure to wind, rain, sun and public interaction. They must be appropriate for a family audience and should pose no hazard to visitors, including children. Artist may not substitute another work without permission and approval. Artist must notify Manchester Arts (MA) of any special anchoring requirements on the application.

The city or MA may take ownership of the work if not reasonably maintained or removed in September, 2018, after the artist has received sufficient notices and the piece is considered abandoned. Neither the city of Manchester or MA can be held responsible for loss or damage to the artwork resulting from theft, vandalism, weather, or other calamity.

**Installation:** Installation will occur in October, 2016 at a mutually agreeable time. Artist must be present at times of installation and removal. Artist responsibilities include (1) transportation of artwork to and from the site; (2) insurance on artwork while transporting, installing/removing, and for the exhibition period; and personal liability coverage during site visits. Selected artists must submit copy of this coverage prior to installation; and (3) maintenance of the artwork during the exhibition period. The city of Manchester will be present at, and assist in, the installation. The city or MA may stop a work from being installed that is substantially different from the proposed work, or poses undue safety or security risks. \$500 honorarium will be mailed to the artist once installation is completed. Artwork is to remain in a public place within the city limits of Manchester as selected by MA and city officials until September, 2018, at which time the artist is to remove it. See list of potential sites (some may need further approval). The city will assist in the removal.

**Artwork Can Be For Sale:** The artist may discuss terms of a sale with potential buyers, but the city is prohibited from advertising it for sale or having the price listed. Whether a sale is made or not, the piece cannot be removed prior to September, 2018. The displayed work will be identified by artist name, contact info if desired, title of work, and "Manchester Arts Sculpture Exhibit". The artist will receive all proceeds from a resulting sale, MA will not take a percentage.

**Selection Panel:** The panel will consist of MA Public Art Team members, MA Board members, a Manchester city official, Mark Weber - Chair of Arts Dept at St Louis Community College, Wildwood, and Dan Tierney - Deputy Director of Regional Arts Commission.

**Entry Details:** Artists may submit up to 3 applications, one for each artwork. Each application must be accompanied by 2 or 3 photos of the work from different angles. There is no entry fee. Applications to be emailed to [arts@manchestermo.gov](mailto:arts@manchestermo.gov). Alternatively, they can be mailed or delivered to Kat Douglas - Parks Office, 359 Old Meramec Station Rd, Manchester MO 63021. Clearly identify each photo with artist name and artwork title. Artist must be 18 years of age or older. There is no geographic limitation on artist residence.

**Application Details:** Each submission must include:

- Completed application, see attached
- 2 or 3 photos of artwork from different angles, of which the artist attests to owning outright, each photo to include artist name and title of work
- Any special requirements for installation and anchoring

**Manchester Arts** is a city Council principally supported by Manchester city, the Regional Arts Commission, and the Missouri Arts Council. MA seeks to inspire engagement in and appreciation for the arts. MA reserves the right to use images of the artist's work for marketing and promotional purposes.
