- **How can I vote?**
 - In-person
 - Absentee
 - Mail-In (ALL registered voters are eligible to vote by mail-in ballot in 2020)

- **I selected the mail-in voting option, received my ballot and completed it; do I need to have it notarized?**
 - Yes, all individuals who select the mail-in voting option need to have their ballot notarized.

- **I selected the absentee voting option, received my ballot and completed it; do I need to have it notarized?**
 - Yes, UNLESS you are incapacitated or confined due to illness or physical disability, or you have or are at-risk for contracting or transmitting COVID-19 and selected these reasons on your ballot envelope.

- **Where can I get my ballot notarized?**
 - The City of Manchester has notaries ready to notarize your ballot.
